About

Hope in Christ Mission C.B.O appreciates the need for unity and cooperation in all aspects of our social, cultural, economic and political life. We are aware of the challenges that we face and being keen and determined to addressing those challenges, we do hereby commit ourselves to mobilizing the community internal and external resources: Join our efforts and those of non-state, state development players and likeminded Organizations to ensuring improved life.

Hope in Christ Mission C.B.O aim at addressing challenges faced by orphan and vulnerable children, address many the numerous cases of Sexual and Gender Based Violence (SGBV) and related problems in Kitale through provision of safe space for SGBV survivors, provision of basic education and economic empowerment of Adolescent Girls and Young Women (AGYW) to speak out and be leaders in their own spaces.

Today, because of the overwhelming cases of SGBV, parental neglect and Orphans and Vulnerable Children (OVC), Hope in Christ Mission C.B.O started a safe space with a lower primary school to accommodate the growing numbers of children who are of school going age. We are located at: Transnzoia County, Kitale Town

BACKGROUND

Hope in Christ Mission C.B.O is in Kitale Town. Kitale Town is an agricultural town in the northern Rift Valley, situated between Mount Elgon and the Cherangany Hills. The town has an elevation of around 1,900 metres Its population is 162,174 as of 2019. Kitale is the headquarter town of Trans-Nzoia County. Kitale is reachable by air through Kitale Airport.

Kitale lies between Mount Elgon and Cherang'any Hills is 72.3 km (44.9 mi) by road north west of Eldoret.

Focus:

Our program provides a holistic and multi-disciplinarian approach to strengthen the capacity of families and communities to address poverty, SGBV and HIV/AIDS epidemic. The effects of poverty and HIV/AIDS epidemic are evident and prevalent in Kitale; the number of widows, orphans and child headed households. For a young person growing up in Kitale; gangs, illicit brewed alcohol and prostitution are all coping mechanisms to survive. Economic and health development in these communities are crippled by lack of infrastructure, clean water and healthcare facilities. Children Care and Support:

Hope in Christ Mission focuses on strengthening the capacity of families and communities to care and protect their OVC through a holistic and multi-disciplinary approach, first by prolonging the lives of HIV-infected and then by supporting the children orphaned by AIDS. The program's emphasis is on assisting OVC within the family/community setting allowing the OVC to socialize, learn and address challenges within their own environment. Currently we are hosting over 87 children in our Children's home who receives basic care including shelter, medication, education (ECDE and Primary Schooling), and clothing.

Adolescent Girls and Young Women Empowerment

Hope in Christ Mission has been bringing Adolescent Girls and Young Women together and equipping them with skills and knowledge in Sexual reproductive health and rights information, income-generating activities and leadership skills to enable them start sustainable projects for self-sustainability and be leaders in their own spaces.

Health and Counselling

The impact of Sexual and Gender Based Violence is vast on health in terms of personal suffering, health complications, disability, and death for women, children and men, in addition to having significant costs for healthcare systems and society at large and many of survivors in Kitale are suffering in silence. Hope in Christ Mission through community initiatives and authorities identify and offer free counselling services to these population.


Water and Sanitation

Hope in Christ Mission envisions improved knowledge, attitude and practice (KAP) in environment, health, water, hygiene and sanitation (WASH) in community. We are motivated by our belief that a clean environment promotes healthy community. Hope in Christ Mission does this by working with health and environment clubs and use of targeted-community awareness approaches including community health days, school health education and community Barraza, county government of Transnzoia to create awareness about importance of proper sanitation and hygiene.

Education:

We make sure the children are enrolled, retained and progressing through each education/vocational training level. Scholar's days featuring career talks help to encourage and direct children to make informed choices regarding their futures. As a result of receiving appropriate and quality education, they become responsible and contributing members of society. The community benefits from school fees payment which is an activity geared towards education. Hope in Christ Mission also provides shoes to school going girls aged 5-16 years and books to children aged 5-16 years.






